



## Cops were deputies

The pair of uniformed officers who ordered a Canton couple to remove a garage sale sign at Sheldon and Arlington last week were sheriff's deputies, not participants in a political hoax, authorities report.

John and Phyllis Evans of 43160 Arlington in Canton were ordered last week by two men, posing as police officers to take down their garage sale sign at the corner of Arlington and Sheldon roads in accordance with an ordinance said to exist in Canton.

## Slaughterhouse motion nixed

A motion by a Canton slaughterhouse owner to have a township civil suit against him dismissed has been denied in Wayne County Circuit Court.

The motion, filed on behalf of Dale Risinger, owner of the Red Meat Slaughterhouse on Geddes Road in Canton, asked that the case be dismissed because it was allegedly "resolved in a criminal proceeding before the 35th District Court on Dec. 3, 1975."

In denying Risinger's request, Circuit Court Judge Roman Gribbs said although the case had been tried previously in criminal court, "a criminal

proceeding does not preclude a civil action subsequent thereto even though it involves the same parties and subject matter. The proofs in criminal proceeding must show guilt beyond a reasonable doubt, where the plaintiff may prevail in a civil case by a preponderance of the evidence only."

Canton filed suit last year against Risinger for expanding a business with a non-conforming use and for changing the use of the building.

Risinger won the suit last December and Canton soon thereafter filed its civil suit in Circuit Court.
