And right now is the best time of the year for transplanting in most parts of the country. It is extremely important to transplant after the first heavy frost (usually October - November) when

you are certain the plant is dormant. In mild areas such as Southern California or Florida frosts do not normally occur and plants do not defoliate completely. In these areas strip all the leaves off first and transplant in late December or early January.

First, prune the bush back to about two feet -- give or take a few inches, depending on how large a grower the
