

Franklin ties Bentley on disputed goal

A disputed goal with a little over six minutes remaining gave Franklin a one all-tie with Bentley in Suburban Hockey League competition.

After two scoreless periods where only five penalties were called, Bentley broke the ice at 6:30 in the third period.

Bob McCann bested Franklin netminder Don Perrie, Mark Sybda assisting, with Franklin playing three men out front to Bentley's four.

At 4:44, Bentley's Bob Wasilowski and Franklin's Bob Justina went off for holding. With just 24 seconds remaining in the penalties, Franklin's Dan Longway was called for charging and 17 seconds later, McCann flipped a loose puck in the Franklin net.

Bentley's Greg Rakowicz was called for elbowing at 7:24 and with 42 seconds remaining in the power play, Franklin's Livesay batted down a high shot in front of the Bentley net. Bulldog defenseman Brad Anderson checked Livesay and the puck bounced into the Bentley net off of Livesay.

Bentley goalie Russ Brown disputed the play but the goal stood as it was a Bentley defenseman that shoved the Franklin player into the puck which wound up in the Bentley net.

The Bulldogs now sport a 4-1-1 mark and Franklin a 2-2-1 record.

It will be an all Livonia show tonight at Ford Rink as Bentley takes on defending champion Stevenson in the 7 p.m. game. Bentley Coach Mike Dudley is the first to admit that his Bulldogs have not beaten Stevenson in three years.

Churchill at 2-2 is pitted against Franklin in the 9 p.m. clash.

It was a night for non-league battles. An evening where 13 Observerland cage squads took the court, six emerging as victors. Livonia Churchill, Clarenceville, Garden City West,

Westland John Glenn, Plymouth Salem and Southfield Lathrup chalked up another notch in the victory column. Southfield, St. Agatha, Farmington Harrison, Garden City East, Plymouth Canton, Stevenson and Thurston all recorded setbacks.

Pat Montagano's Churchill Chargers bounced back up after a heart-breaking loss to Franklin with a 70-54 triumph over the Southfield BlueJays.

Three minutes into the contest, it was 9-2 Southfield but the Chargers got untracked

early and were on top after one quarter, 14-13.

It was nip and tuck the rest of the half with Churchill holding a 30-27 upper hand. Two free throws by Greg Miller got Southfield to within one after three quarters, 49-47.

But the Charger machine was yet to explode.

Rich VanWagoner opened with a three-point play and Churchill proceeded to best the Blue Jays, 22-7, in that quarter. The Chargers hit six of 18 from the floor, Don Braun popping in nine of his 24 points.

Churchill's most impressive statistic was in the rebound game where it battled to a 53-54 conquest with

It's prep wrestling weekend at Schoolcraft Invitational

Coach Don Haney's Wayne Memorial squad is heavily favored to successfully defend its title at Schoolcraft College's fourth annual high school invitational wrestling tournament this weekend.

According to Larry Meyer, coach of the Schoolcraft College team and meet director, only two schools, Farmington and Bay City Western, have even an outside chance of blocking Wayne's bid for a second straight championship.

The meet gets underway today (Friday) with the two qualifying rounds and the quarterfinal taking place in a schedule that begins at 1 p.m. and wraps up around 10 p.m.

The meet will end tomorrow (Saturday), with semi-

final action slated to begin at 1 p.m. and conclude at 5:30 p.m. with championship rounds set at 7 p.m.

Rapidly developing a reputation as one of the top schoolboy mat tournaments in the state, the Schoolcraft Invitational will feature four returning individual champions.

Clawson's Bob Sade won the 98 pound championship last year. Wayne has two champions from the 1973 tourney to bolster its chances of defending the team title. They are Steve Fedulchek who won the 126 pound title, and Larry Silvestri who coped the 132 pound championship.

Joe Dixon. A 185 pounder last year, Dixon is favored to win the heavyweight bracket this year.

Other teams entered are Allen Park, Annapolis, Bay City Western, Birmingham Groves, Chelsea, Clarenceville, Clawson, Farmington, Farmington Harrison, Garden City East, Highland Park, John Glenn and L'Anse Creuse.

Brouhaha looms for Mocerri hearing

A full-scale community tug-of-war is expected to erupt next Tuesday night at a Canton Township public hearing involving the Mocerri regional shopping center project.

The meeting will be held at 8 p.m. in the UAW Local 900 Hall at 38110 Michigan, west of Canton Center Road, on the south side (eastbound lane) of Michigan.

The planning commission will hear public comment on the request of the Mocerri Building Co. for the rezoning of 65 acres of farmland at Joy and Sheldon roads to a commercial designation.

Mocerri proposes to build a regional shopping center that

includes a 500,000 square foot retail shopping facility plus a 250,000 square foot recreational-office complex.

The commercial phase of the Mocerri project has remained unchanged since its original submission to the planning commission more than a year ago, according to Canton planner Michael Manore. An accompanying housing development, however, has been altered, he added, to meet stringent demands recommended by the commission.

Who the tenants of the huge shopping center will be has not been revealed by either Mocerri or the firm that will act as the rental agents, Manore added.

To give residents a com-

parative view of the size of the project, the Mocerri project in its entirety would be larger than neighboring Westland Center, which has about 550,000 square feet of retail space, Manore said.

He also stated that up for public view - but not discussion - was the planned unit development (PUD) that Mocerri will submit to the planning commission very shortly. It contains the changes suggested by the commission.

"I hope that the meeting won't revolve around the PUD," said Manore. "The plan will be there merely to indicate to the public the use of the land between the shopping center and the existing homes."

The planning commission can either reject the rezoning request or recommend its approval to the township board. However, even a rejection by the planning commission could be overridden by the township board if the developer appeals the decision.

Indications point to a heavy turnout of residents, many of them members of homeowners group vehemently against the project.

At least one planning commissioner will be unable to attend the hearing because of a previous commitment. He is Bob Simmons, one of two newer members of the commission and a former member of the Citizens Advisory Council studying land use patterns.

Simmons told the Plymouth Mail and Observer Tuesday night that he leaves this weekend for a week-long state farm board conference. He said he and his wife made plans for the trip long before he was appointed to the planning commission.

By his absence, the project's proponents lose one of their supporters. Simmons has publicly stated he favors a shopping center in that location but adds that the township should drop the project "if the people are against it."

One chief supporter of the plan is Planning Commission Chairman Wes Kaiser. He feels the project would provide a balanced tax base since most of the industry in the 36-square mile township is located in the southern part.

With Simmons absent and

2 troopers honored

Salem dumps Canton

An 85-52 victory Tuesday over Plymouth Canton sends Plymouth Salem into tonight's Suburban Eight showdown with Allen Park boasting a 7-2 mark for the season — which won't be nearly as impressive as it sounds unless the Rocks win. Allen Park, which reached the state Class A quarter-finals in 1972 and won the Sub 8 title last year, comes into Plymouth again leading the league at 3-0.

Salem, Livonia Bentley and Dearborn, which Salem takes next Tuesday on the road, are bunched in second place at 2-1. From now on every game is a must in what is building up as one of the Sub 8's best championship scrambles in years.

For the second game in a row it was 6-6 sophomore Jim Ellinghausen who set the scoring pace for the Rocks as they whipped Canton's Chiefs in the first basketball game ever between the two schools. The transfer from Peoria whipped in 12 of 21 shots from the floor for 24 points, posting 18 in the first half.

Salem's 6-9 junior pivotman, Eric Agardy, shared secondary scoring honors with Dave Prueter, each with 14 points. Ron Lack was high for the hustling but out-manned Chiefs with 17. Tom Close aided with 16.

The winless Chiefs, now 0-7 in their first season of varsity competition, were out-rebounded 29-10 in the first half as Salem raced to a 41-23 lead.

After three periods Salem held a 61-33 margin and Coach Fred Thomann emptied his bench in the final quarter, 12 of the 15 men

who played getting into the scoring column.

Agardy's presence in the Salem lineup adds extra flavor to the battle with Allen Park. Coach Mike O'Hara had presumed the youngster would follow in the footsteps of his 6-11 brother, Tom Agardy, who led the Jaguars to their '72 and '73 successes.

However, last summer the Agardy family moved into the Plymouth School District so the father could be closer to his job at Chevrolet Spring and Bumper.

Now Agardy is a Plymouth starter and chances are he will be a marked man when he faces his former buddies tonight.

Designer John Anthony goes to black and white for spring

Designer John Anthony's entire spring collection for 1974 is in black, white, or black and white.

"After so much color, it's the only thing that looks right to me," he says. The only patterns I use are woven stripes or printed dots. The only accent is red. Red to me is also a basic — a neutral color," he says.

There is not a synthetic fabric in the collection because Anthony believes the synthetics never will meet the standards of a beautiful piece of crepe de chine or a fine piece of wool crepe or silk georgette.

The length of the clothes is below the knee or longer. The collection has very few coats. It plays up the dress and jacket, the three-piece costume and the knee-length coat with pants and a skirt and above all, the suit. Of the suit, he says, "It's the thing I believe women will want to climb into this spring. It's a new complete look, very slicked up, rather dressy, yet simple, like they looked at Chantilly or Long-champs or Belmont."

The jackets are set close, with finely-moulded shoulders, and the blouses always move to one side with a crisp bow or a shiny flower. It is a collection where hats are de rigueur. "I think women will welcome hats and also very fine-looking jewelry," the designer said. "I've chosen mine to carry out the black and white theme, in dark gunmetal with pearls."

JOHN ANTHONY designed this dress in nun's veiling, a sheer white wool with woven black stripes. Above the bouncing pleated skirt is a dog leash belt in reptile and a perky black bow.

Cranbrook exhibits explain artists' work

Two special exhibitions will explain artists and their work through two different methods at Cranbrook Academy of Art Museum Jan. 15.

Exhibited through Feb. 10 will be "Projected Art: Artists at Work," including slides, films and tapes of more than 140 artists.

On exhibit through Feb. 17 will be "Le Corbusier at Pessac," with architectural models and original design sketches of one of the Swiss architect's earliest and most important projects, the "Quartier Moderne Fruges" at Pessac, France.

"Projected Art: Artist at

Work," through the medium of 1,000 slides and 18 films and videotapes, provides the viewer with a rare opportunity to visit the artist at work in his studio, whether it be a conventional room or salt flats, underwater or the desert.

Not only does the viewer visit the studio, but he also may watch performances by the artists who create their works on film.

In the viewing area next to the slide show, which will include simultaneous projection of sequential slides onto six viewing areas, the visitor may see in the four hours of films, ranging from three

minutes to 35 minutes, Robert Smithson depositing a huge earth spiral in the Great Salt Lake in the film "Spiral Jetty," or Claes Oldenburg create his giant ice bag in "Sort of a Commercial for an Icebag."

Other artists included are Vito Acconci and Mel Bochner (conceptual), Robert Motherwell (expressionist), Charles Hinman, Lee Krasner and Jack Youngerman (hard edge), Eva Hesse (independent), Stephen Antonakos and Don Flavin (light sources), Alexander Calder, Jasper Johns, Ferdinand Leger, Jaques Lipschitz and Picasso (master artists), Roy

Lichtenstein (pop), Helen Frankenthaler (stain painting), John Clem Clark and Philip Pearlstein (super-realists) and Don Judd (minimal).

The show was organized by Elayne Varian, director and curator of the Contemporary Wing, Finch College Museum of Art, New York. She spent seven years on this project visiting and documenting artists in their studios. It is sponsored by the New York State Council for the Arts.

"Le Corbusier at Pessac," or the search for system and standards in the design of low cost housing, is an exhibition that treats for the first

time in the United States the philosophy and methodology of the architect Charles Edouard Jeanneret, known as Le Corbusier (1887-1965).

With some original works, comprehensive original photographs and a great deal of recent research, this exhibition attempts to present a comprehensive view of Le Corbusier's ideas on a problem of continuing importance - to provide housing for large numbers of people that is healthful, humane and low in cost.

This study of Pessac, with its prefabricated modular units, industrialized and standardized methods, is signifi-

cant for our time because the Pessac houses proved to be amenable to many changes that suit individual owners' preferences. Pessac has thus displayed the kind of flexibility that designers today seek to achieve.

The exhibition of this early project of Le Corbusier's is also a measure of his contribution to contemporary architecture in that he arrived at stunning new formulations on the basis of material and experiences that had been available to all his contemporaries - but unlike most of them, he was not content to settle with traditional house forms.

Father Borkowski is Navy chaplain

"Father Tom," Our Lady of Loretto's young pastor for more than four years, now is Lt. Thomas Borkowski of the U.S. Navy.

He recently completed chaplain school in Boston and is serving in the U.S. Naval Hospital in Oakland, Calif.

He decided on the move af-

ter a satisfying first pastorate in the Redford Township Catholic parish because "basically I was looking for a new challenge — a new way to serve and grow as a priest and as a person."

"In talking with men in vice," Lt. Borkowski said before heading for California, "I realized there is a real need on their part for someone to talk to."

"And I like the ecumenical nature of the chaplain's work. I'll be serving Catholics, of course, but others too, helping provide for religious needs and serving as a counselor and a friend to all who need me."

Lt. Borkowski, a native of Wyandotte, went to high school and college at St. Mary of Orchard Lake and then on to seminary at St. John in Plymouth.

He found the eight weeks in chaplains' school as varied and intensified as any training he has had.

"There was the indoctrination into the Navy and Marines, of course," he said, "but also a wide variety of other experiences."

"We had seminars at Boston University on racism and on the young adult, trying to understand better his approach to life and to God. There was also a seminar on dope addiction and how the chaplain can help a serviceman or woman who has become dependant on drugs."

The course also included an evening in a commune and a visit to Roxbury, the slum area of Boston.

Then there was a night and day in prison at Portsmouth, N.H., — "we were treated as prisoners, by our consent" — and a week on the destroyer USS Cecil.

"I was with a group of re-

servants from Detroit and most of us were seafarers," Lt. Borkowski admitted. He also had a chance to try out, on land, the "Holy Halo" lift the Navy uses to transport chaplains from one ship to another by means of a harness dangling from a helicopter.

In the Oakland hospital, which is basically for the treatment of psychiatric and orthopedic patients, he will be part of a five-chaplain team.

"I want to be someone who listens — helps these people resolve conflicts."

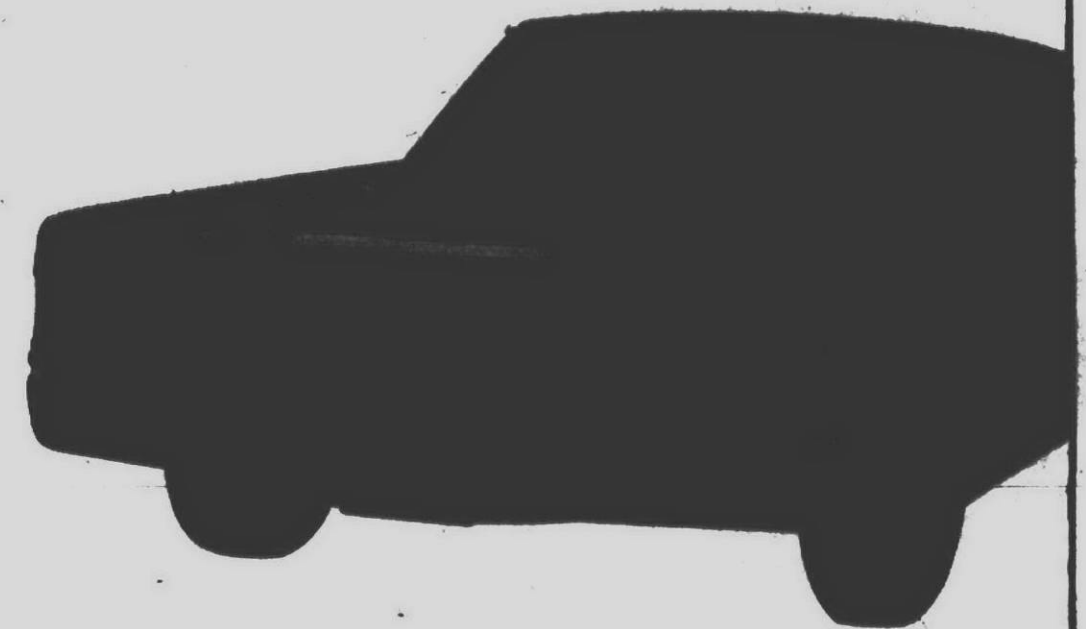

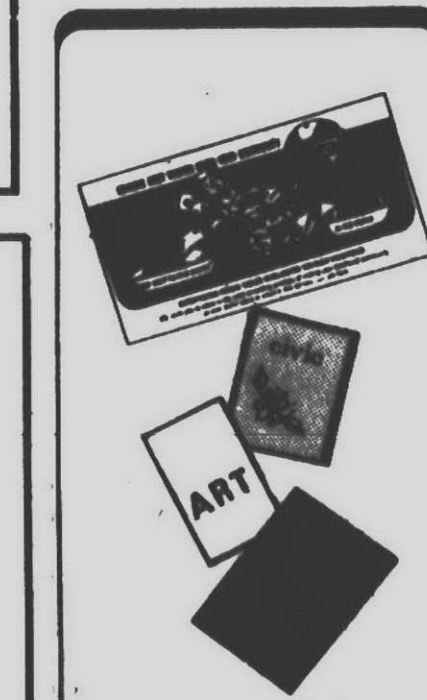

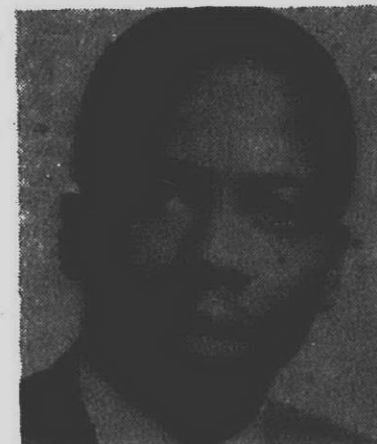
