

Churchill cagers top Bentley Bulldogs

It was a 12 win - 14 loss week for area prep cagers.

The 19 school Observerland contingency, which dipped to a .412 winning percentage last week upped its overall showing to .88 - 119 for a current .425 percentage.

A 17 contest card is on tap tonight with area clubs predicted to come out of it all with seven wins and 11 losses.

Two key loop battles highlight tonight's action with a 5-1 Riverside club invading a 7-0 Garden City West squad in a Tri-River showdown and the area's No. 1 club, Churchill, traveling to Waterford Mott in the battle of the Western Six unbeaten.

In last Tuesday's play, Churchill, Bishop Borgess, Garden City East, Stevenson and Southfield chalk up another notch in the victory column with Bentley, Clarenceville, Plymouth Canton and Southfield Lathrup suffering setbacks.

Churchill dumped city rival Bentley, 64 - 52, for its 10th win against one loss. It was the first contest ever for the Churchill Chargers in the Bentley gym.

Churchill jumped off to an 18 - 12 first quarter edge and maintained its margin at the half, 34 - 28. The closest Bentley got after that was six points early in the fourth with the Chargers taking the second half, 30 - 24.

The Chargers finished 27 of 66 from the floor for 41 per cent, with Don Braun popping in a season high of 23 points along with hauling in 18 rebounds. Churchill won the rebound battle, 38 - 21.

"I had a shakey feeling about playing in the Bentley gym," said Churchill Coach

Pat Montano. "We contained their speed and that was the game."

"We tried to practice for this one with half the lights out in our gym," joked Montano on the subject of subdued lighting in the Bentley gym.

Now comes Churchill's key game in the Western Six Conference as the Chargers travel to Waterford Mott tonight (Friday) to face a 9 - 1 Mott squad that like Churchill sports a 4-0 loop mark.

"This ought to be a real barn-burner," added the Churchill coach. "If we don't take away their fast-break, it won't be much of a contest. Mott has been scoring about 40 points a game on its fast-break alone."

The Clarenceville Trojans dropped No. 11 against one loss in a 64-52 game against the Northville Mustangs. After trailing, 22 - 15 after one quarter and 44 - 35 at the half, the Trojans tied it at 46 all early in the third period but to no avail.

Northville increased a 52 - 46 third quarter lead with a 12 point showing in the fourth while holding Clarenceville to just six. Northville out-rebounded the Trojans, 42 - 24.

Garden City East pulled out a squeaker over Melvindale in a non-leaguer, 46 - 45.

Melvindale led after one quarter, 10 - 8, but East jumped to a 24 - 20 margin at the half, and 35 - 29 edge after three periods. With five minutes remaining, East was up, 41 - 33, but then missed on three one-and-one situations.

With 29 seconds showing on the clock, East still enjoyed a four point lead but Pete Siska hit a bucket and free-throw to make it 46 - 45.

East then missed a one-and-one and Melvindale had one last shot.

Siska drove to the bucket, flipped it up - the buzzer went off and the ball rolled off the rim. East shot a 31 per cent from the floor and Melvindale, 35 per cent.

The Southfield Blue Jays snapped a four game losing streak in a 62-58 win over Wyandotte. Southfield hit 22 of 51 for 43 per cent, Ira Labensky scoring 24 and Wyandotte shot 22 of 48 for 47 per cent.

It was Southfield's third victory against eight defeats.

Jim Brisky's Bishop Borgess cagers broke a four-game losing streak over Dearborn Sacred Heart, 74 - 70. It was Borgess' third victory overall in 12 starts.

Greg Drypen's 30 points paced Borgess which shot 50 per cent from the floor, 32 of 64.

Southfield Lathrup fell to Dearborn in another non-leaguer as Dearborn out-scored the Chargers, 27 - 15, in the final eight minutes to capture a 79 - 65 win.

Game scoring honors wound up in a deadlock as Lathrup's Jim Ballantyne and Dearborn's Jim Tracz popped in 36 each.

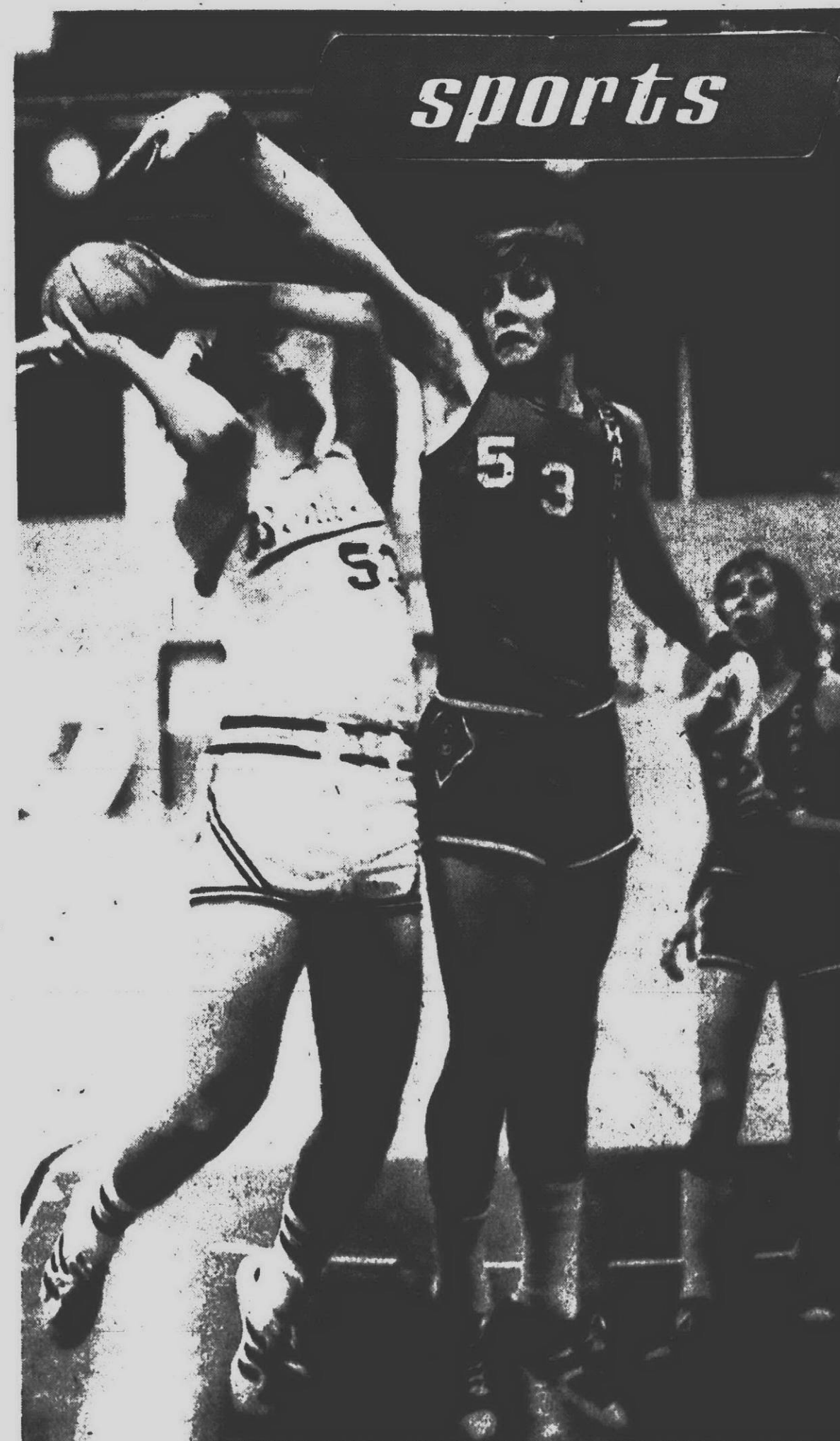

City, township sponsoring study of consolidation

Plymouth Township and the City of Plymouth have agreed to share in funding a study of consolidation.

The study, which would cost a maximum of \$3,000, would be conducted by Michigan State University's Institute for Community Development which conducted a similar study in the Farmington area.

Thus far it is, not known whether the university has agreed formally to do the study although the Plymouth Township Board voted Tuesday night and the City Commission agreed informally Monday night to share in sponsoring it.

March 7 was the deadline given for the study. That would be just under four weeks before voters in the city and township vote in a state - ordered consolidation election.

While the specifics of what the study would investigate

have not yet been pinpointed, one facet, which the township insisted be considered, is the economic impact of unification on the residents of both communities.

When it voted unanimously to co - sponsor the study from MSU, the Plymouth Township Board also authorized Supervisor J. D. McLaren to approach the city about getting two separate studies done.

The other study, McLaren said, could be done by the University of Michigan but its cost was not known.

The MSU group was recommended by a five - member steering committee made up of city and township residents. That committee also talked to the UM researchers.

Ed Sawusch, a local industrial leader; Nancy White, the representative of the area League of Women Voters; Esther Hulsing, former

school board president; and Fred Yockey, Plymouth city manager, are on that committee along with a representative of the township government. (Both Elizabeth Holmes, treasurer, and McLaren have met with the committee.)

Dr. Gary Hall, who coordinated the petition drive that put the consolidation issue on the ballot, has also met with the committee.

The State Boundary Commission, after finding Hall's 1970 petitions legally sufficient to call for an election, set the binding referendum in the two communities for April 2.

If the majority of voters in each of the two communities approve the consolidation issue, a second election would be held May 7 to elect nine charter commissioners who would be charged with writing a charter for the new city.

'Why can't girls take shop classes?'

Two Plymouth School District mothers struck a blow for womanhood at the seventh grade level. It has prompted the school board to order an administration review of the entire curriculum to remove any further traces of sexual discrimination.

The action came at the Jan. 14 meeting when the two mothers, Donna K. Henkel and Jeanette Shanks, charged the board "prescribes classes that are in direct violation of Title 9 of the education amendments of 1972."

They charged that their daughters have been denied the opportunity to take industrial arts classes only on the basis of their sex.

Mrs. Henkel reported that her daughter, Pamela, a student at Plymouth Middle School, has been required to take a home living course for

approximately 15 weeks, while her industrial arts class offering was limited to approximately five weeks.

"She is presently taking a course entitled, 'Let's Have a Party' as an elective," Mrs. Henkel told the board. "If the schools view education for party giving important to seventh grade students, then the opportunity to develop their potential in industrial arts should be of greater importance," she added.

Her colleague Mrs. Shanks told a similar story. Her daughter, Diane, also a student at a middle school, has finally been given permission - over the shop teacher's objection - to enter the class on Feb. 1.

Mrs. Shanks told the board that "It has been strongly stressed to me by both the principal and the shop teacher that she will be the only girl in the class, with the caution that the experience

might prove an unfavorable one for her."

Both mothers cited the unequal basis on which seventh grade girls are offered an industrial arts experience. The boys' portion of the class runs 14 weeks, covering seven units of course instruction.

The girls' portion extended only four weeks with only five units being covered, the mothers contended.

Deleted from the girls' portion of the program were units dealing with foundry, wrought iron and sheet metal.

The mothers were told, they said, deletions were made because "girls didn't like to dirty their hands; and they might cut their hands in the sheet metal classes." In addition, the mothers added, they were told that a safety problem concerning the long hair of girls was a factor.

Born into a musical family, Sarah Roth was expected to be musically inclined. It turned out just that way.

She also indicates that she and other students have become acquainted with the sound of a Bell on Liberty Street in Ann Arbor.

Her ambition? "To play with a symphony."

Area's 'first lady of the pulpit' mourned

A lady whose ministerial career might be called a modern church miracle is gone from the pulpit of Clarenceville United Methodist Church in Livonia.

And the Rev. Elsie A. Johns, who died Tuesday at the age of 69, will be missed personally by just about all the 1,200-plus members of the church she built literally from nothing.

"More as family than pastor," was how one of them put it.

Elsie, as she was known to everyone from tiny children up, died as she had lived, serving her congregation.

Her last service was Watch Night communion on New Year's Eve. Few of those present then realized that three days later she would leave her Farmington home for Botsford Hospital and the final battle with the long illness that had kept her in considerable pain in recent months.

Bishop Dwight E. Loder of the Detroit Conference of the UMC conducted her funeral Friday in the sanctuary of the new church she and her

congregation built and dedicated in September of 1972.

Rev. Johns was a Detroit businesswoman, life-long church worker and recent seminary graduate when the conference, back in 1941, sent her out to the dilapidated frame church on Grand River west of Eight Mile.

It was a job turned down by male graduates because it included neither salary nor parsonage.

A note on the organ informed Elsie when she arrived that Clarenceville Methodist also lacked congregation and funds. She set about to build both.

Beginning with the Sunday school, the church began to grow again. "There was no plumbing in the building," Elsie remembered years later, "so we used to take the children to the restroom at a gas station on the corner."

Under her guidance, the church was repaired and the congregation soon filled it. By 1954, the minister quit her job as billing supervisor for National Twist Drill and Tool Co. and became full time pastor.

Four years later the site at 20300 Middle Belt was purchased, and the educational unit was completed in 1966.

The \$400,000 sanctuary, one of the most striking church homes in this area, was completed in 1972.

It contains a chapel named in Elsie Johns' honor by grateful parishioners who also, over the years, have given her several checks to finance her favorite recreation—travel.

Her most recent trip was a

long-anticipated journey to the Holy Land. She also traveled from Clarenceville around the world and to South America.

Rev. Johns, who called her ministry "definitely conservative" always had services Sunday evening as well as morning.

Her church's annual Bible school came to be known as one of the biggest in Methodism, drawing hundreds of children and always starting with a parade in the Clarenceville area.

Les McCabe, principal of Pierson Junior High School in Redford Township and long-time member of Clarenceville, tried to sum up Rev. Johns' ministry.

"She was tops in church administration, and she worked well with everyone from children to the elderly," he said.

"She had a drive I've never witnessed in anyone—I'm sure conference records will show no one made more home and hospital calls."

"Her examples for living were Jesus Christ, the apostle Paul, John Wesley and Mike Rice of Metropoli-

tan Methodist in Detroit. I have found it a real privilege to work with her for the last 19 years."

Mrs. Gertrude Weak and her husband, Emery, were the first couple married by Elsie Johns, and Mrs. Weak said after the pastor's death, "I'll never have a better friend."

"She did everything so beautifully, and she spoke in so many churches that people seemed to know her all over Michigan."

Although Rev. Johns never married, she leaves a successor in the Methodist ministry. A niece, the Rev. Carol Johns, is one of several young women ordained in recent years. She is serving in the First United Methodist Church in Saginaw and on a recent Sunday in Clarenceville substituted for her ailing aunt.

A fitting tribute came from the Rev. William A. Ritter, minister of Newburg United Methodist in Livonia. "One of the favorite parlor games of Methodist ministers has been to ask 'How would you like to replace Elsie Johns?'" he said.

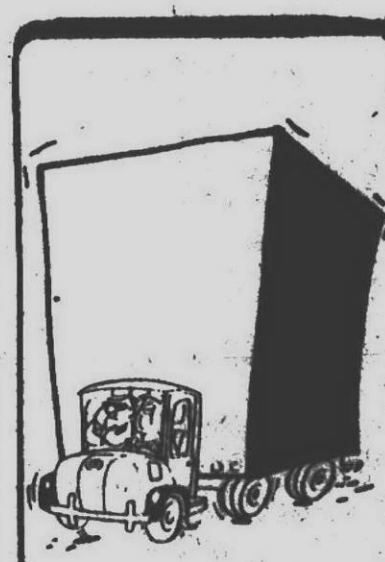
Mr. Thombley died Jan. 21 at his home after a long illness. He had lived in the area since 1959 and was a former machinist for Chase Co. of Detroit.

men when he first read about it back in 1968.

The program was new in the archdiocese, and the young teacher felt it was a role in which he could function well.

"But when I applied I was told I was too young," Krzeminski said.

He didn't let that stop him from taking the training with a group of men who did meet the age requirement of 35. While he was doing so, the archdiocese sent a special request to Rome, and eventually the age requirement was lowered by 2½ half years.

Before he reached that age, Krzeminski was assigned to assist the Rev. Joseph Ferens, pastor of St. Colette, located 17600 Newburgh.

On Dec. 9, in a mass in St. Colette, he was ordained by the Most Rev. Joseph Imesh, auxiliary bishop of the archdiocese.

On hand for the occasion were Mrs. Krzeminski, who specifically promised her support to her husband's ministry, and the couple's children, Mike, 12; Larry, 5, and Stacey, 2.

The Krzeminskis make their home in Livonia. Their home parish is St. Damian, Garden City.
