

# Churchill runs past Canton

With some key personnel missing, Plymouth Canton's boys track team couldn't keep pace with Livonia Churchill Tuesday in its final Western Lakes Activities Association dual meet of the season, losing 73-64.

The Chiefs finish third in the division at 3-2, behind Walled Lake Western and Churchill. The WLAA Conference Championships will be Tuesday at Farmington HS.

Missing from the lineup against Churchill was Corey Walser, Canton's top sprinter. Walser is nursing a sore hamstring, his availability for Saturday's state regionals in Dearborn is uncertain.

Still, the Chiefs had a chance to beat the Chargers, until their 4x100-meter relay team was disqualified.

Among the outstanding efforts turned in by Canton was Dane Kobus, who tied the school record (set by Chris Kalis in 2000) in winning the 110 hurdles in 14.8.

Ken Page was Canton's only double winner in individual

events, capturing the long jump (21-feet, 1 1/4 inches) and the 200 dash (24.0).

Last Saturday at the Troy Athens Relays, Canton placed third out of 21 teams with 24 points.

Finishing first for the Chiefs was the long jump relay team of Page, Kobus and Dan Driscoll (58-1 1/2) and the shuttle hurdles team of Pawel Paszkowski, Page, Bharminder Singh and Kobus (1:02.9). In the non-scoring thrower's relay, Canton's Brandon Wright, Brad Waidmann, Bryan Frawley and Singh also finished first (1:43.5).

Waidmann, Mike Lanus and Page were second in the high jump relay (17-0), Aaron Schmidt, Singh, Jon Szlomis and Aaron Lanning were fourth in the Athens Relay (6:01.3), runners running an 800, a 400, a 400 and an 800, and Brandon McClellan, Schmidt, Szlomis and Lanning took fifth in the distance medley (11:17.9).
